August Program - Danielle Austen: Long Exposure in Nature



Danielle Austen is an award-winning fine art photographer specializing in intimate portraits of the environment.

Educated and trained in the fine arts and photojournalism, Austen's work has been published in local, regional, and national newspapers and magazines, including Life Magazine's, "The Year in Pictures." Returning to her fine art roots, she has attended six Artist-in-Residencies across the United States at locations including the Rocky Mountain National Park, Great Smoky Mountains National Park, twice at Acadia National Park, Everglades National Park, and was a Fellowship recipient at the Vermont Studio Center. In 2014, she was the co-creator and curator of the "NJ350 Elements" photography exhibition displayed outdoors around the Duke Farms Environmental Center in Hillsborough, NJ.

Austen has won awards both in her photojournalism and fine art work, including the past two years receiving honorable mentions in the International Photography Awards. In 2013, she was a national winner of Canon's "Project Imaginat1On" photo competition with Director Ron Howard. Celebrity director, Biz Stone, the co-founder of Twitter, chose her winning image to help inspire his short film, "Evermore" which premiered October 2013 in NYC.

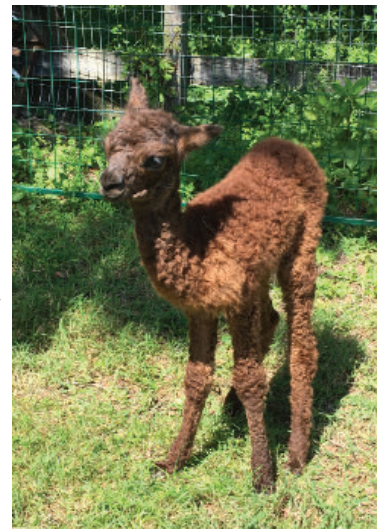
Pohopoco Creek Alpacas:

PPC Executive Committee Meeting Notes – 7/5/17

In attendance: Ann LeFevre, Dick Ludwig, Stephanie Masgula, Terry Flatt, Bill Keenan

The executive committee approved the renewal of a Penn National liability insurance policy due on July 20.

The committee noted a report in the most recent Middle Smithfield Township News thanking Dick Ludwig of PPC for his help in obtaining a new art gallery style hanging system for the Whispering Pines Banquet Hall.

The next PPC shoot-out, arranged by Stephanie Masgula, is scheduled for July 15 at Blakeslee Farm on Middle Road in Stroudsburg. The theme is light-writing.

The committee discussed the need to print up liability release forms for those participating in PPC shoot-outs, just to be on the safe side in case anyone is injured in any way.

PPC's photo exhibit at the Shawnee Inn went well, and the reception was well attended. The committee discussed how additional signage and advance promotion might have contributed even more. We also talked about investing in better wiring to have available for exhibits of this type.

We will be taking down the exhibit at Shawnee Inn on Sunday, July 30 at 10 a.m., and members can pick up their photos on July 31.

The next Stroudsburg Farmers Market that PPC will be participating in will be on August 5 (Kid's Day), and at our next general meeting we will want to urge more members to contribute 8x10 or 11x14 photos.

The committee also had a preliminary discussion on the upcoming election in December.

GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT OUR CLUB

Would you like to be a "CURTAIN RAISER"

"Curtain Raiser Photos" are the photos shown prior to the start of regular PPC monthly meetings.

- The photos can be any subject of your choosing suitable for a general audience.
- There should be a maximum of 40 images.
- The images should be in JPEG format.
- The JPEG's should be about 1MB or more in size so they will display at full resolution.
- The JPEG's can be any resolution – ideally a resolution of 1440 pixels on the long side of the image matches the resolution of the projector but this is not essential.
- The images can be on a USB Thumb/Flash, CD, DVD or on a camera memory card - But you must supply a USB Card Reader to plug into the computer.
- If you want to show the slides in a specific order number them by putting 01 thru 40 as the first part of the file name. This way the computer will order them 1-40.
- Curtain Raiser Presenters are scheduled by PPC President.
