Curtain Raisers, workshops, table top discussions and any other public displays of photographs that are being shown as part of a Pocono Photo Club event are considered public presentations. While we understand that photography can include a wide range of "artistic expression", Pocono Photo Club strives to maintain a "G rated", family friendly, climate since we have a broad spectrum of people who will be both coming to our meetings, exhibits, and other activities and viewing our pictures. PPC does not censure a person's choice of photographic genre. However we expect all members who are displaying, discussing, or presenting their work in a PPC function whether to the membership or the public to keep this in mind and select images accordingly. Pictures such as full frontal nudes, those involving sexual intimacy, or graphic images of violence and horror are considered beyond the general scope of our viewing audience and are discouraged for use in any of the aforementioned venues. Should there be any question as to whether or not your particular image is appropriate please check with the Executive Committee first before putting your image on display.
